RESOLUTION NO. 70-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE
A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES
CONTROL BOARD AND THE SPACE DIVISION,
NORTH AMERICAN ROCKWELL CORPORATION, TO
CONDUCT A PILOT AERIAL SURVEILLANCE STUDY

WHEREAS, the Board believes that aerial surveillance techniques may offer significant advantages to the regional boards for improving the inventory of wastewater sources and facilitating water quality monitoring activities, and

WHEREAS, responsive proposals for conduct of the work have been received from competent technical firms in accordance with a Request for Proposals dated February 4, 1970, and


WHEREAS, upon consideration of these proposals, that furnished by the Space Division, North American Rockwell Corporation, is considered to be in the best interests of the State of California, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board enter into a contract with the Space Division, North American Rockwell Corporation, for conduct of the study at a cost not to exceed \$10,000, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Officer of the Board is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Board.
