RESOLUTION NO. 71-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION SERVICE FOR A STUDY OF LAGOON PERMEABILITY FOR SAN JOAQUIN, STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the Board plans to consider policy and requirements for wastewater disposal from agricultural operations including dairy and poultry ranches, and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that further information is needed regarding the efficacy of structures used in the disposal of dairy and poultry wastes, and

WHEREAS, a responsive proposal has been received from the University of California Agricultural Extension Service to carry on such research as is needed relative to such structures, and


WHEREAS, upon consideration of the above proposal it is considered to be in the best interests of the State of California, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that, subject to the availability of general funds, this Board enter into a contract for the 1971-72 budget year with the University of California Agricultural Extension Service, Stanislaus County, in the amount of \$1,000, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Officer of the Board is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Board.
