RESOLUTION NO. 71-47

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE JOINT ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE, SANTA MARGARITA AND SAN LUIS REY WATERSHED PLANNING AGENCIES FOR ASSISTANCE IN PREPARATION OF WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANS

WHEREAS, the State Board is preparing statewide comprehensive water quality control plans in accordance with the Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. Ch. 23 and the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, Water Code, Division 7, and

WHEREAS, the Joint Administration Committee of the Santa Margarita and San Luis Rey Watershed Planning Agencies is presently engaged in a water quality management study for these two basins and a contract between the Board and the Joint Administration Committee will prevent duplication of effort and be very advantageous financially to the Board, and


WHEREAS, the Joint Administration Committee indicates that its personnel can provide this input to the Board for the Santa Margarita and San Luis Rey Subbasin Planning Areas located in San Diego Basin No. 9 on a contractual basis therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorize the Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, to execute an agreement with the Joint Administration Committee for assistance in the preparation of the comprehensive water quality control plan for the San Diego Basin No. 9 Planning Area, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the contract between the State Board and the Joint Administration Committee shall be applicable for the period of approximately November 4, 1971, through June 30, 1973, and shall not exceed an amount of \$30,000.
