## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 73-28

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH CORPORATION S OF SAN FRANCISCO FOR KEY PUNCH SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR DATA PROCESSING SERVICES TO AUTOMATE THE PROCESSING OF THE 1973 SEWERAGE NEEDS SURVEY

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water Grant Program staff is cooperating with EPA in coordinating the 1973 "Needs Survey" for wastewater treatment facilities.
- 2. The information from the "Needs Survey" will be used to determine the nationwide distribution of federal construction grant funds for F.Y. 1974-75 and F.Y. 1975-76.
- 3. The information from the "Needs Survey" should be key punched and preserved on magnetic tape:
  - a. To make a timely and meaningful analysis of the projects eligible for grant funding;
  - b. Update the statewide five-year needs to substantiate California's share of Congressional appropriations for construction grants;
  - c. Preserve the data in a form that can be merged with the file being established by the Office of Technical Coordination on waste facilities and enforcement actions.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The State Water Resources Control Board authroizes the Executive Officer to execute a contract with Corporation S of San Francisco for key punch services in an amount not to exceed \$5,100, and a contract with the Department of General Services to automate the processing of the 1973 Sewerage Needs Survey in an amount not to exceed \$4,700.
