## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 73-42

# STATE BOARD POLICY REQUIRING APPROVAL OF REGIONAL BOARD GUIDELINES

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Regional Boards may adopt guidelines to implement various provisions of water quality control plans or waste discharge requirements or regarding enforcement actions.
- 2. The State Board must approve all water quality control plans before they become effective.
- 3. A proper and orderly review by the State Board of Regional Board guidelines is necessary to implement properly water quality control plans and other Regional Board actions.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. Guidelines adopted by a Regional Board for the implementation of a water quality control plan, adoption of waste discharge or reclamation requirements, execution of enforcement actions or for any other action reviewable by the State Board shall not become effective unless and until approved by the State Board.
