RESOLUTION NO. 73-49

BASSA'S REGIONAL WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLAN 1973 (Interim)

WHEREAS:

1. Section 16650 of the California Water Code provides that the Bay Area Sewage Services Agency, hereafter BASSA, shall develop and adopt a regional water quality management plan for the San Francisco Bay region and the remainder of Contra Costa County.
2. Section 16650 further provides that the content of the plan shall include at least a facilities plan, including a system or systems for conveyance, treatment, reclamation and disposal of municipal and industrial wastes in such a manner as to meet state policies, plans and requirements, and an implementation plan, including identification of those agencies who should be responsible for construction and operation of such facilities, a recommended timetable for construction of such facilities, and a proposed financing plan including apportionment of costs.
3. Section 16667 of the Water Code states:


"Prior to adopting the proposed regional water quality management plan, the agency (BASSA) shall submit it to the State Water Resources Control Board for a finding that the proposed plan is in conformity with policies, plans and objectives adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board and the appropriate California regional water quality control boards for any and all waters within the region and for those waters outside the region which may have any effect inside the region in the development of the regional water quality management plan."
4. BASSA has submitted its proposed Regional Water Quality Management Plan 1973 (Interim) which contains a "Table I" on pages 8-11, entitled "Wastewater Facilities Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin".
5. BASSA has requested that the State Water Resources Control Board make a finding that the plan set forth in the aforementioned Table I conforms to State and Regional Board plans, policies, and objectives in accordance with Section 16667 of the Water Code.
6. Said plan as submitted by BASSA does not contain a recommended timetable for construction of facilities or a proposed financing plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Table I of the BASSA proposed Regional Water Quality Management Plan 1973 (Interim) is in conformity with policies, plans, and objectives adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board and the appropriate California regional water quality control boards for any and all waters within the region and for those waters outside the region which may have any effect inside the region in the development of the regional water quality management plan.
2. The State Board makes no finding whether the proposed Regional Water Quality Management Plan 1973 (Interim) fulfills the requirements of the Bay Area Sewage Services Agency Law.
