STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 73-50

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA POLLUTION CONTROL FINANCING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS:

- 1. Health and Safety Code Section 39615 provides that no project to construct water pollution control facilities will be eligible for financial assistance from the California Pollution Control Financing Authority unless the State Water Resources Control Board certifies that there is reasonable assurance that (a) the project is necessary to further comply with applicable state and federal standards, and (b) the project is consistent with an approved regional, basin, or state plan for environmental protection.
- 2. Health and Safety Code Section 39615 also provides that the California Pollution Control Financing Authority shall reimburse the State Water Resources Control Board for making the required certifications.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Water Resources Control Board authorizes its Executive Officer or any person delegated by the Executive Officer to enter into an interagency agreement with the California Pollution Control Financing Authority to provide for compensation to the State Board for the cost of the certifications required under Health and Safety Code Section 39615.
