## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-8

REVIEW OF ACTION OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION, REGARDING SEWAGE BYPASS BY THE CITY OF ARCATA

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board), held hearings under the authority contained in California Water Code Section 13350, on January 16 and 23, 1974, regarding a raw sewage bypass to Humboldt Bay by the City of Arcata.
- 2. The Regional Board adopted Order No. 74-19 in which it made specific findings that the City of Arcata had violated waste discharge requirements and that a pollution, nuisance and contamination occurred as a result of the bypass.
- 3. Order No. 74-19 reprimanded the City of Arcata for failure to promptly notify appropriate agencies of the bypass but did not request the Attorney General to seek civil monetary remedies as allowed by law.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Water Resources Control Board, pursuant to Section 13320 of the California Water Code, will review the action of the Regional Board in adopting Order No. 74-19.
