STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-13

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT TO STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. 1-2-57, SANTA ANA WATERSHED PLANNING AGENCY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board, through consultants contracting with the Board, is preparing Comprehensive Basin Water Quality Control Plans for the 16 planning basins in California.
- 2. The Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 (PL 92-500) require consideration of additional factors not presently contracted for by the Board.
- 3. The new report plan outline will accommodate the Board's desire to approve only the required elements of a water quality control plan.
- 4. The additional work required because of changes to the report plan outline and PL 92-500, includes the following:

Rewriting the basin plan reports in conformance with the new plan report outline;

Providing editorial review and graphics of surveillance material prepared by staff;

Classifying segments into water quality or effluent limitation classes and ranking thereof according to severity of pollution;

Ranking groundwaters as to degree of mineralization and water deficiency; and

Performing waste load allocations necessary to meet standards for water quality class segments.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That this Board enter into contractual amendment with Santa Ana Watershed Planning Agency for the work required in the amount of \$55,000 of the Clean Water Bond Funds and for the extension of the completion date to August 31, 1974.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, be authorized to execute the amendment to Standard Agreement No. 1-2-57 on behalf of the Board.
