STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-20

AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF NECESSARY AGREEMENTS TO IMPLEMENT AFFIRMATIVE ACTION WATER QUALITY TECHNICIAN TRAIN-ING PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board, as a matter of on-going policy, has expressed support of affirmative action programs.
- 2. The Board will benefit directly from a work/study program for training water quality technicians.
- 3. Significant funding is available from sources other than the State's support appropriation.
- 4. California has been a recognized leader in the field of water quality control and enhancement, and this program is viewed as a model which may be adopted nationwide by other governmental agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board affirm its previous decisions relating to affirmative action programs and the training of water quality technicians.
- 2. That the Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute such agreements with the California State University at Sacramento, State Personnel Board and Orange Coast Community College as are necessary to implement this Water Quality Technician Training Program in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 in total, to be composed of a maximum of \$4,500 in General Fund money, \$18,000 in Federal grant funds, and the remainder of \$47,500 to be reimbursed by the State Personnel Board.
