STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-50

ADOPTING THE F. Y. 1974-75 ANNUAL STATE STRATEGY AND DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARDS TO IMPLEMENT THE STATE STRATEBY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Annual State Strategy for F. Y. 1974-75 is a statement to the people of California on the accomplishments of the State's water quality control program for the past fiscal year, and the program goals and plan of implementation for the coming F. Y. 1974-75.
- 2. The State Strategy contains a statewide assessment of water quality problems and the causes of these problems to assist the State in directing resources planning, monitoring, permitting, and financial assistance against water quality problems on a priority basis.
- 3. The Annual State Strategy lists and describes water quality control programs and actions to be taken by the nine Regional Water Quality Control Boards and the State Water Resources Control Board in accordance with the geographical and discharger priorities contained in the strategy.
- 4. The 1972 Amendments to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act and its pursuant regulations require each state applying for an EPA Program Grant to prepare an annual strategy for conducting the state's water quality control programs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. This Board adopts the Annual State Strategy for F. Y. 1974-75.
- 2. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards and the Executive Officer of the State Water Resources Control Board are directed to implement the Annual State Strategy for F. Y. 1974-75.
