## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-74

AUTHORIZATION TO CONTRACT WITH CONVERSE, DAVIS AND ASSOCIATES FOR REVIEW OF THE PROPOSED KAISER-RADUM SANITARY LANDFILL

## WHEREAS:

- Kaiser Industries has proposed to construct an extensive sanitary landfill in the Livermore Valley;
- 2. Such a proposed project could have a significant impact upon the quality of the extensive groundwater resource in the area of the proposed project;
- 3. The feasibility of the project is directly related to appropriate seismic design and stability analysis which is an area outside the general expertise of the staff of the State Water Resources Control Board;
- 4. Converse, Davis and Associates, Consulting Engineers and Geologists, are recognized experts in the field of seismic analysis, soil mechanics and soil stability analysis.

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board authorize the Executive Officer of the Board to enter into a contract with Converse, Davis and Associates in an amount not to exceed \$8,000 for an initial review of the proposed Kaiser-Radum Sanitary Landfill.
