STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-80

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO DEVELOP INITIAL UNITS OF A MARINE AND ESTUARINE MONITORING PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board is required to coordinate the establishment of a statewide surveillance and monitoring program, including the marine environment, to measure compliance with state and federal pollution laws.
- 2. The Board has expressed its intent to coordinate its program with other state agencies and departments with existing programs for water quality sample collection and analysis.
- 3. The Department has qualified personnel and laboratory facilities available to sample and analyze various parameters necessary to develop a program and evaluate conditions in the marine environment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute an Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$69,000 of federal grant funds for the period ending December 31, 1975, between the State Board and the Department of Fish and Game to establish sampling at seven ocean stations and one bay station, to collect and analyze samples, and to report the results.
