RESOLUTION NO. 76-2

APPROVING RESOLUTION 75-12 OF THE LAHONTAN  
REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS:

1. At its November 5, 1975, meeting, the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan, South Lahontan Basin (Resolution 75-12), which will prohibit the discharge of waste from leaching or percolation systems in the Hilton Creek/Crowley Lake Area of Mono County.
2. The discharge prohibition is reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding the geologic conditions in the Hilton Creek/Crowley Lake Area and the documented high incidence of individual disposal system failures.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Resolution 75-12 of the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, South Lahontan Basin.
