STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-13

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
CONCERNING THE STATE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT OF 1974 (PUB. L. 93-523)
BETWEEN THE
STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD,
THE
STATE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES,
AND THE
STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974 (Pub. L. 93-523) is concerned with providing safe, wholesome drinking water for public water systems and with providing adequate control of underground injections which could endanger underground sources of drinking water.
- 2. To accomplish these purposes, the Act prescribes a separate regulatory program for public water systems and for underground injection control. The Act provides for primary enforcement responsibility by the states, if a state meets certain requirements, and for federal action in the event of failure by a state to assure enforcement. In addition, the Act authorizes a program of federal guaranteed loans made by private lenders to small public water systems. It is anticipated that EPA will require state certification of appropriate projects.
- 3. To ensure a coordinated approach in carrying out the foregoing programs, the parties to this agreement believe it is highly desirable to develop various understandings with regard to implementation of the Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974 (Pub. L. 93-523).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute on behalf of the State Board the proposed Memorandum of Agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board, the State Department of Water Resources and the State Department of Health.
