STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-20

APPROVAL OF THREE-AGENCY AGREEMENT FOR THE SAN JOAQUIN INTERAGENCY DRAINAGE PROBLEM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board, the State Department of Water Resources, and the United States Bureau of Reclamation have interests and responsibilities with respect to drainage water in the San Joaquin Valley.
- 2. An urgent need exists for development of a master plan for the management of drainage water in the San Joaquin Valley.
- 3. The State Board, the Department, and the Bureau wish to develop such a master plan under the joint guidance of the three agencies, each to bear one-third of the associated program costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute on behalf of the State Board, an agreement substantially in conformance with the proposed agreement between the United States of America and the State of California to cooperate in a San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program at a State Board cost not to exceed \$101,400 for the period July 1, 1975, through September 30, 1978.
- 2. That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to designate a Board Member as a member of the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program Policy Group.
