STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-47

CERTIFYING THE FINAL 208 WORKPLANS OF THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board on May 15, 1975, adopted Resolution No. 75-33 designating the boundaries of the ABAG 208 planning area and the Association of Bay Area Governments as the planning agency for such area.
- 2. The Association of Bay Area Governments has submitted a workplan to the State Board which describes the work program to be undertaken during the next two years to develop an areawide plan for the San Francisco Bay Area.
- 3. Federal regulations require the State Board to certify or refuse to certify the workplan of designated 208 planning agencies.
- 4. The Board has considered the recommendations of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, the Air Resources Board, the Office of Planning and Research, and other interested agencies with regard to certification of the subject workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board certifies, with respect to the Association of Bay Area Governments workplan, that:

- The proposed work complies with state requirements;
- The proposed planning work program is adequate and necessary to accomplish the development of a plan under Section 208;
- 3. Insofar as is known, planning will not duplicate the facilities planning requirement of federal regulations; and
- 4. The workplan should be approved by EPA.
