RESOLUTION NO. 76-48

CERTIFICATION OF THE 208 GRANT APPLICATION AND INITIAL WORKPLAN
SUBMITTED BY THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL AREA PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS:

1. On April 15, 1976, the State Water Resources Control Board designated the Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission (SRAPC) as the area-wide waste treatment planning agency for all of Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba Counties.
2. On May 11, 1976, SRAPC submitted to the State Board a 208 grant application, which includes a workplan outline, for certification as provided in federal regulations (40 CFR 35).
3. The proposed planning work program presented in the workplan outline is consistent with conditions set forth in the State Board's Resolution No. 76-26 designating SRAPC.
4. The proposed planning work program appears to be adequate and necessary to accomplish the development of a plan under Section 208 of PL 92-500.
5. By November 1, 1976, SRAPC will submit a final workplan to the State Board for review and comment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the 208 grant application, which includes a workplan outline, submitted by the Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission is certified as follows:
 - a. The proposed work complies with state requirements;
 - b. The proposed planning work program is adequate to accomplish the development of a plan under Section 208;
 - c. Insofar as is known, planning will not duplicate the facilities planning requirements of federal regulations; and
 - d. The workplan should be approved by EPA.
2. The foregoing certification is subject to State Board review and approval of the final workplan to be submitted by SRAPC prior to November 1, 1976.
