STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-52

APPROVING ORDERS NOS. 76-89 AND 76-88 OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS:

- 1. At its March 26, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plans, Sacramento River Basin and Tulare Lake Basin, which will prohibit the discharge of waste from leaching or percolation systems in the following areas:
 - o Clearlake Park and Clearlake Highlands, Lake County
 - o Three Rivers Area, Tulare County
- 2. These discharge prohibitions are reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding the geologic conditions in the designated areas and the threat of contamination of surface and groundwaters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Orders Nos. 76-89 and 76-88 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plans, Sacramento River Basin and Tulare Lake Basin.
