STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-57

EXECUTION OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE STATE BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENTS OF WATER RESOURCES, FISH AND GAME, AND HEALTH TO IMPLEMENT A COORDINATED PROGRAM FOR WATER QUALITY SURVEILLANCE AND MONITORING IN CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board has the responsibility to coordinate water quality-related investigations of state agencies, and to conduct necessary surveillance and monitoring activities.
- 2. A multiagency "Memorandum of Understanding" was executed on August 27, 1974, between the State Board and the Departments of Water Resources, Fish and Game, and Health for the purpose of coordinating data management and water quality-related data collection programs of various state agencies.
- 3. The State Board, in concurrence with the Regional Boards, has completed development of a statewide monitoring network and intends to implement said program, pursuant to authority granted under Section 13001 and the directive under Section 13163 of the Porter-Cologne Act, for a coordinated water quality control program.
- 4. The Departments of Water Resources, Fish and Game, and Health have the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desire to provide such services to the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Interagency Agreements with the Departments of Water Resources, Fish and Game, and Health to implement a coordinated program for water quality surveil—lance and monitoring for an amount not to exceed \$237,300 for the period ending September 30, 1977.
