STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-63

OCEAN PLAN REVIEW AND CONTRACT APPROVAL

WHEREAS:

- 1. At previous State Board Workshops, the Board has directed the staff to conduct a complete review of the WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN-OCEAN WATERS OF CALIFORNIA;
- 2. It appears that a workable regulatory approach would consist of development of water quality objectives for the protection of marine resources and through a process of evaluating the available initial dilution models to translate these objectives into actual effluent limitations on a case-by-case basis;
- 3. There is a need to obtain estimates of the initial dilution capability of existing ocean outfalls and to provide a uniform basis on which such estimates are made;
- 4. There also exists a need to provide field verification of these initial dilution models to ensure that accurate predictions are possible.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Officer to negotiate and execute a contract with the University of California for providing the necessary technical services to estimate and verify the initial dilution at existing ocean outfalls. This contract shall be for a sum not in excess of \$120,000.
