AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR PREPARATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY INTERAGENCY DRAINAGE PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board has entered into an agreement with the Department of Water Resources and the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation to establish the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program (IDP).
- 2. The objective of IDP is to develop and implement a management program to resolve San Joaquin Valley agricultural drainage problems.
- 3. For its participation in IDP, the Board has been asked to prepare an environmental assessment to screen agricultural disposal options associated with conceptual alternatives for agricultural drainage water management.
- 4. A request for proposals has been sent to qualified prospective consultants for the preparation of the aforementioned assessment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Officer to negotiate and execute a Standard Agreement for the preparation of an environmental assessment for the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program.
