# STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-84

# CERTIFYING THE FINAL 208 WORKPLAN OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL AREA PLANNING COMMISSION

### WHEREAS:

- The Board on April 15,1976, adopted Resolution No. 76-26 designating the boundaries of the Sacramento 208 planning area and the Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission (SRAPC) as the planning agency for such area.
- 2. SRAPC has submitted an initial workplan to the Board which describes the work program to be undertaken during the next two years to develop an areawide waste treatment management plan for the Sacramento Area.
- 3. SRAPC prepares an "integrated grant application" (IGA) for submittal to all state and federal funding agencies.
- 4. SRAPC has requested that the State Board consider certification of their initial workplan as the final workplan to allow timely integration with the IGA process which commences July 1.
- 5. Federal regulations require the Board to certify, or refuse to certify, that the workplans of designated 208 planning agencies meet four specific tests identified in the federal regulations.
- 6. Staff of the State Board, Central Valley Regional Board, Air Resources Board, and Office of Planning and Research have expressed concern that SRAPC's initial workplan is not sufficiently detailed to allow proper review and comment.
- 7. SRAPC has agreed to prepare detailed work programs for each subelement of the initial workplan.

#### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board certifies, with respect to the Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission's workplan that:
  - The proposed work complies with state requirements;
  - The proposed planning work program is adequate and necessary to accomplish the development of a plan under Section 208;
  - Insofar as is known, planning will not duplicate the facilities planning requirement of federal regulations; and
  - The workplan should be approved by EPA.



2. That the Board's certification of the workplan is subject to the following condition:

That SRAPC prepare and submit to the Board by July 19, 1976, detailed work programs for each subelement as revisions to the final workplan.
