PROPOSED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
STATE BOARD AND THE U. S. FOREST SERVICE DELINEATING
208 PLANNING RESPONSIBILITY ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM
LANDS

WHEREAS:

1. Regulations in 40 CFR, Part 130, authorize a state agency to delegate water quality planning responsibility, with the approval of the Regional Administrator, to other state, federal, local, or interstate agencies for the conduct, where appropriate, of any portion of the State's required water quality planning.
2. Regulations in 40 CFR, Part 130, direct federal agencies to cooperate and give support to the State or designated areawide planning agencies in the formulation and implementation of the water quality control plans relative to federal property.
3. A Memorandum of Understanding between the U. S. Forest Service and the State Board will provide a framework for the coordinated development and implementation of those portions of Regional Water Quality Control Plans pertaining to National Forest System lands.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute on behalf of the Board a Memorandum of Understanding between the State Water Resources Control Board and the U. S. Forest Service.
