STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-93

REVIEW OF ACTION OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION, REGARDING ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, PITTSBURG, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS:

- 1. On May 4, 1976, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Regional Board) conducted a hearing regarding enforcement action against the United States Steel Corporation for alleged violations of pH effluent limits by United States Steel Corporation at its Pittsburg plant.
- 2. After hearing, the Regional Board issued Cease and Desist Order No. 76-51 which allowed United States Steel Corporation until May 27, 1977, to come into compliance with pH effluent limitations at its Pittsburg plant, and declined further enforcement action against United States Steel Corporation.
- 3. After consideration of the circumstances surrounding the aforementioned violations by United States Steel at its Pittsburg plant, it appears to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) that the failure of the Regional Board to take any additional enforcement action in this matter should be reviewed by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will review, on its own motion, the failure of the Regional Board to take additional enforcement action in this matter.
