STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 102

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO CONTINUE PAIRED STATION MONITORING ON THE LOWER AMERICAN RIVER FOR THE NATIONAL WATER QUALITY SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board has coordinated the sampling and analysis at the two National Water Quality Surveillance System (NWQSS) stations in California for the past year and one half.
- 2. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requested the monitoring of specified parameters at these paired stations on the lower American River as part of the National Water Quality Surveillance System.
- 3. The National Water Quality Surveillance System was established pursuant to Section 104(a)(5) of PL 92-500 and the State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for implementing PL 92-500 in California.
- 4. The Department of Water Resources has agreed to continue contractual services for this program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Board authorize the Executive Officer to negotiate and execute a contract with the Department of Water Resources in an amount not to exceed \$19,100 for the continued sampling and laboratory analysis on the lower American River, with funding up to \$4,500 of State General Fund monies from the F. Y. 1976-77 budget, subject to the remaining funds being provided by EPA.
