STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-111

RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ADDITION OF TAYLORSVILLE COUNTY SERVICE AREA TO CLEAN WATER GRANTS PRIORITY LIST FOR FISCAL YEAR 1976-77

WHEREAS:

- The Central Regional Water Quality Control Board by Order No. 76-129 has adopted a prohibition against further installation of leaching and percolation systems within the Taylorsville County Service Area, and has established a timetable for elimination of all discharges from such systems in that area by January 1, 1980; and
- 2. The State Board has approved that prohibition; and
- The Plumas County Health Department has documented the existence of a serious public health problem in the Taylorsville County Service Area; and
- 4. The Taylorsville County Service Area is presently an unsewered community and its wastewater treatment facilities project now qualifies for placement in Priority Class B in the State Board's Clean Water Grants Priority List for Fiscal Year 1976-77.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the State Board waive Section 2108(f) of the Clean Water Grant Regulations; and
- 2. That the Fiscal Year 1976-77 Clean Water Grants Priority List be amended to include the Taylorsville County Service Area wastewater treatment facilities project in Priority Class B; and
- 3. That the State Board hereby directs the Taylorsville County Service Area to include in its Facilities Plan a discussion and analysis of all alternative solutions to its water quality problems including, but not limited to, construction of traditional community wastewater collection and treatment facilities, establishment of a septic tank maintenance district, institution of a septic tank rehabilitation program, and installation of alternative individual disposal systems; and
- 4. That no grant for Step 2 or Step 3 work be given for the Taylorsville County Service Area wastewater treatment facilities project until the above alternative solutions are studied and analyzed to the satisfaction of the Division of Water Quality.
