## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-116

ESTABLISHMENT OF REGIONAL POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEES AND A STATE PROGRAM REVIEW BOARD AS PART OF THE 208 PLANNING PROGRAM IN NONDESIGNATED AREAS

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is the responsible agency for the development of a water quality management plan for nondesignated areas of the State pursuant to Section 208 of PL 92-500.
- 2. Federal planning regulations, 40 CFR, Part 130, require the establishment of a policy advisory committee, with a majority membership of chief-elected officials of local units of government, to advise the State in the development and implementation of water quality management plans.
- 3. The establishment of Regional Policy Advisory Committees fulfills the requirements of federal planning regulations.
- 4. The establishment of a State Program Review Board, comprised of policy-level representatives of governmental agencies and public and private interest groups, will provide for review and coordination of issues of statewide concern.
- 5. The establishment of Regional Policy Advisory Committees and a State Program Review Board will provide for active involvement by potential implementing agencies.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to establish a State Program Review Board as part of the 208 planning program in nondesignated areas.
- 2. That the Executive Officer distribute to the appropriate Regional Boards a Program Guidance Memorandum for the establishment of Regional Policy Advisory Committees.
