RESOLUTION NO. 76-122

RESOLUTION REGARDING REQUEST FOR PARTIAL GRANT FUNDING OF GREEN VALLEY LAKE PROJECT NO. C-06-0832

WHEREAS:

- 1. A request for partial grant funding of the collection system for San Bernardino County Service Area No. 79 (Green Valley Lake), dated November 4, 1976, has been received by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board).
- 2. The request seeks a waiver of the permanent residency requirements of Section 2107(a)(7) of the State Board grants regulations, (Subchapter 7, Chapter 3, Title 23, California Administrative Code) to allow partial grant funding of the Green Valley Lake's collection system based on the percentage of improved parcels occupied by permanent residents.
- 3. Statements have been received that the project will place an undue financial burden on the low income permanent residents of Green Valley Lake.
- 4. The Green Valley Lake collection system is part of a regional system which also involves the communities of Running Springs and Arrowbear Park.
- 5. The State Board, in Resolution No. 75-85, provided partial funding for the Running Springs project to assist existing permanent residents in Green Valley Lake.
- 6. There is some question as to whether legal means can be found to allow the benefit of grant funding to be available only to the permanent residents of the area.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. A partial waiver of Section 2107(a)(7) for the Green Valley Lake collection system to be granted to allow grant funding of the Green Valley Lake's collection system project on the basis of the percentage of the improved parcels occupied by permanent residents.
- 2. No grant contract be given unless Green Valley Lake can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Water Quality Division that the benefit of the grant funds will accrue only to the permanent residents to be served by the collection system.
