## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-4

APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. 76-7 ADOPTED BY THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION

## WHEREAS:

- 1. Guidelines adopted by a Regional Board for the implementation of a water quality control plan, adoption of waste discharge or reclamation requirements, execution of enforcement actions or for any other action reviewable by the State Board shall not become effective unless and until approved by the State Board. (State Water Resources Control Board Resolution No. 73-42)
- Regional Boards may adopt guidelines to implement various provisions of the water quality control plans or waste discharge requirements or regarding enforcement action.
- 3. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region adopted Resolution No. 76-7 on December 2, 1976, concerning the implementation of the State Water Resources Control Board's "Minimum Guidelines for Protection of Water Quality from Animal Wastes" in that portion of Marin County under the Regional Board's jurisdiction.
- 4. Resolution No. 76-7 reflects the continuing effort by the Regional Board to bring all animal confinement facilities into compliance with the State Board's animal waste guidelines.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to State Board Resolution No. 73-42 approves Resolution No. 76-7 adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region on December 2, 1976.
