STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-12

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH LACSD FOR A STUDY OF "HEALTH ASPECTS OF GROUNDWATER RECHARGE WITH RECLAIMED WATER IN THE MONTEBELLO FOREBAY"

WHEREAS:

- 1. Division 7, Chapter 7, Article 2 of the State Water Code directs the State to "...undertake all possible steps to encourage development of water reclamation facilities so that reclaimed water may be made available to help meet the growing requirements of the State".
- 2. The Board has adopted a "Policy and Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California" to implement the legislative directive contained in the Water Code. A Research and Demonstration program was identified as an important part of the Action Plan.
- 3. The Board placed this project high on the proposed "List of Potential Wastewater Research and Demonstration Projects for F. Y. 1976-77 and 1977-78" included in the Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California.
- 4. The Consulting Panel on Health Aspects of Wastewater Reclamation for Groundwater Recharge identified research needed before further decisions can be made regarding water reclamation projects.
- 5. The Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD) proposes a study which will address several of the research areas recommended by the Consulting Panel.
- 6. LACSD submitted a proposal for Phase I of this study to the State Board and requested Board participation in funding of this study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Officer be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with LACSD to conduct the first phase of the study of "Health Aspects of Groundwater Recharge with Reclaimed Water in the Montebello Forebay" for a period of six months and for an amount not to exceed \$36,000.
