STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-14

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN DELTA, AND SAN JOAQUIN RIVER BASINS (5A, 5B, AND 5C)

WHEREAS:

- 1. At its December 17, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, and San Joaquin River Basins, which modify the Basin Plan compliance schedules to prohibit waste discharge into the following water bodies:
 - o Jackson Creek above Jackson Creek Reservoir
 - o American River, including Lake Natoma, from Folsom Dam to mouth
 - o Woods Creek
 - o Sacramento River, Feather River confluence to Freeport Bridge

and which require the control of untreated discharge of combined waste from the City of Sacramento at the earliest practicable date.

2. Such compliance schedule modifications are reasonable and necessary since existing compliance schedules cannot be met due to municipal facilities construction delays and since the existing compliance schedules must be modified before revised compliance schedules can be adopted in NPDES permits.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve Resolution No. 76-262 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, and San Joaquin River Basins (5A, 5B, and 5C).
