ADOPTING THE REPORT "WATER QUALITY RESEARCH NEEDS IN CALIFORNIA" AND AUTHORIZING ITS PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION

- 1. The Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act directs the Board to determine state needs for water quality research.
- 2. The staff has prepared the report "Water Quality Research Needs in California", after obtaining input from various state agencies and others involved in water quality research.
- 3. The Board desires the staff to implement the research recommendations in the Board's program and to encourage other agencies and groups to conduct research on these subjects.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board adopt the report as policy of the Board regarding water quality research.
- 2. The Board authorizes the printing and distribution of 1000 copies of the report.
- 3. The Board directs the Executive Officer to implement the research recommendations in the Board's program.
- 4. The Board directs the Executive Officer and the Division to work with other state agencies through the Interagency Programming Committee to encourage the conduct of studies in their respective areas of expertise.
- 5. The Board directs the Executive Officer and the Division to communicate with federal agencies and other research supporting organizations to encourage research on the subjects recommended in the report.
