APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY PLAN, SANTA ANA RIVER BASIN (8)

WHEREAS:

- 1. At its March 18, 1977, meeting, the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan, Santa Ana River Basin (Resolution No. 77-87), revising the Basin Plan compliance time schedule to prohibit waste discharge for subsurface leaching-percolation systems in the following areas:
 - 1. Yucaipa-Calimesa (Yucaipa Valley County Water District) July 1, 1980
 - 2. Bear Valley, which includes the Baldwin Lake Drainage Area July 1, 1980
- 2. Such compliance schedule modifications are reasonable and necessary in light of the testimony received at the March 18, 1977, public hearing held by the Regional Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves Resolution No. 77-87 of the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Santa Ana River Basin (8).
