### STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-61

# APPROVAL OF THE PARTIAL 208 WORKPLAN FOR THE NONDESIGNATED AREA OF CALIFORNIA

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board is the responsible agency for conducting water quality management planning in the nondesignated area of the State pursuant to Section 208 of PL 92-500.
- 2. On June 18, 1976, EPA offered the State Board a grant in the amount of \$2,345,316 for conduct of the nondesignated area planning program.
- 3. A partial workplan has been prepared which sets forth interregional and Colorado River Basin Region planning issues to be addressed and a program budget.
- The workplan identifies contractual needs, including proposed contracting agencies and funds to be allocated to each agency.
- 5. Identification of regional issues for the North Coastal, Central Coastal, Central Valley, and Lahontan Regions has been delayed to allow for review by Regional Policy Advisory Committees.
- 6. Regional workplan issues for the aforementioned regions will be submitted to the State Board for consideration at the State Board's July 21, 1977, meeting.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- That the State Board approves the partial 208 workplan for the nondesignated area of the State and authorizes the Chairman to submit the partial workplan to EPA for approval;
- 2. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Officer to negotiate and execute agreements with those agencies identified in the workplan to perform tasks as set forth in the workplan in accordance with the nondesignated area program budget.
