STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-64

APPROVAL OF THE FINAL 208 WORKPLAN FOR THE NONDESIGNATED AREA OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board is the responsible agency for conducting water quality management planning in the nondesignated area of the State pursuant to Section 208 of PL 92-500.
- 2. On June 18, 1976, EPA offered the State Board a grant in the amount of \$2,345,316 for conduct of the nondesignated area planning program.
- 3. A partial workplan has been approved by the State Board which sets forth interregional and Colorado River Basin Region planning issues to be addressed and a program budget.
- 4. Regional issues for the North Coast, Central Coast, Central Valley, and Lahontan Regions have been reviewed by the Regional Policy Advisory Committees and approved by the Regional Boards.
- 5. The regional issues identify contractual needs, including proposed contracting agencies, and funds to be allocated to each agency.
- 6. Regional issues for the aforementioned Regions complete the workplan for the nondesignated area planning program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board approves the regional issues portion of the 208 workplan for the nondesignated area of the State and authorizes the Chairman to submit such issues to EPA for approval as the final elements of the nondesignated area workplan; and
- That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute agreements with those agencies identified in the regional issues to perform tasks as set forth in the regional issues in accordance with the nondesignated area program budget.
