STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-93

APPROVAL OF MINIMUM CRITERIA REQUIRED FOR PROPER CLOSURE OF CLASS II SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITES

WHEREAS:

- Without proper closure procedures, Class II solid waste disposal sites can be sources of serious water pollution problems, and;
- 2. Establishing minimum criteria for the proper closure of such disposal sites will protect the quality of waters of the State and inform site operators and owners of their specific responsibilities, and:
- 3. Section 2535 of the California Administrative Code is more easily implemented by adopting these minimum criteria, and;
- 4. Following San Francisco Bay Regional Board staff review and consideration of all pertinent data and testimony received at a public hearing, the aforementioned criteria were developed, and;
- 5. The Regional Board by Resolution No. 77-7 dated July 19, 1977, requested concurrence with these minimum criteria for the closure of Class II solid waste disposal sites.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board approves Resolution 77-7 of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board and finds that enforcement of these minimum criteria will aid in the protection of waters of the State.
