STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-6

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS, FOR A DEMONSTRATION OF OVERLAND FLOW TREATMENT PROCESS FOR TREATMENT OF PRIMARY TREATED MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER

WHEREAS:

- 1. The increasing numbers of small communities becoming eligible for Clean Water Grant funds necessitate consideration of alternative low-cost treatment processes.
- 2. The cost of an overland flow process is substantially less than conventional in-plant treatment processes providing a similar degree of pollutant removal.
- 3. Well-documented design criteria for overland flow are not available and this contributes to the reluctance of many communities to utilize this low-cost process.
- 4. The University of California at Davis proposes to develop a rational approach to the design of an overland flow process and demonstrate this process performance in treatment of primary treated municipal wastewater.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an agreement with the University of California at Davis for thirty-three (33) months in an amount not to exceed \$253,200 for a demonstration of Overland Flow Treatment Process for Treatment of Primary Treated Municipal Wastewater.
