RESOLUTION NO. 78-11

RATIFICATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL PERSONNEL ACT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE
STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD FOR PROVIDING ASSISTANCE
TO THE OFFICE OF WATER RECYCLING

WHEREAS:

1. Governor Brown in Executive Order B-36-77 established the Office of Water Recycling and the goal of construction of facilities to make available an additional 400,000 acre-feet of reclaimed water per year by 1982.
2. To perform the functions of the office and meet the goal it is necessary to develop a technical information program, investigate and promote industrial wastewater reclamation, and coordinate local, state and federal activities related to reclamation.
3. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency has agreed to assign one of its personnel to the Office of Water Recycling to perform these and other tasks.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board hereby ratifies the Intergovernmental Personnel Act agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board and the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency for obtaining an employee to assist the Office of Water Recycling at a cost not to exceed \$45,200 for the period February 1, 1978 through January 31, 1980.
