STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-37

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN INVENTORY OF GROUNDWATER QUALITY MONITORING NETWORKS IN CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. Under the provisions of the Porter-Cologne Act, the State Board is responsible for coordinating and controlling water quality activities within the State, including water quality investigations.
- 2. The State Board is concerned about the adequacy of monitoring networks in major groundwater basins throughout the State.
- 3. The State Board is called upon by various state, federal, and local agencies to provide information regarding groundwater monitoring networks in the State.
- 4. The efficient execution of these State Board activities is dependent on a mechanism by which groundwater monitoring activities can be quickly and accurately referenced.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a cooperative agreement with the U. S. Department of the Interior, Geological Survey, to develop an inventory of active groundwater quality monitoring networks in Priority I groundwater basins for an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the period ending January 31, 1980.
