RESOLUTION NO. 78-45

ACCEPTING THE STAFF REPORT "REVIEW OF POLICY AND ACTION PLAN FOR WATER RECLAMATION" AND DIRECTING STAFF TO TAKE THE ACTIONS RECOMMENDED IN THE STAFF REPORT

WHEREAS:


1. To encourage and promote water reclamation, the State Board adopted in January 1977 the "Policy and Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California."
2. The Policy and Action Plan provided policy with respect to water reclamation and recommended specific actions to encourage the development of water reclamation facilities and the use of reclaimed water.
3. State Board Resolution No. 77-1, an integral part of the Policy and Action Plan, requires that the State Board review the implementation of the Policy and Action Plan by July 1, 1978.
4. The Office of Water Recycling has reviewed the Policy and Action Plan and has submitted its findings and recommendations to the State Board in the report "Review of Policy and Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California by the Office of Water Recycling," August 1978.
5. The Action Plan has essentially accomplished its objective, and further actions to promote water recycling and reclamation are now the responsibility of the Office of Water Recycling in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order B-36-77.
6. The Office of Water Recycling is recommending that the document "Policy and Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California" should not be revised or updated. Instead, the Office of Water Recycling would review and evaluate policy and actions annually, and present its findings and recommendations in a report to the State Board by July 1. The policy and implementation documents contained in the Policy and Action Plan should remain in effect until superseded.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board accept the staff report "Review of Policy and Action Plan for Water Reclamation in California by the Office of Water Recycling," and direct the Office of Water Recycling and appropriate State Board staff to (1) implement the actions recommended in the staff report, and (2) ensure needed actions are taken to effectively encourage water reclamation in California.
