STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-46 AUTHORIZING FUNDING OF THE LOCAL SHARE OF A STEP 1 PROJECT FOR A PILOT STUDY OF SEPTAGE TREATMENT BASINS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board's Clean Water Grant Program has funded nineteen countywide Step 1 Grant studies of management of anaerobic septic tank wastes (septage) which are currently underway.
- 2. Additional information on design parameters and performance of lagoons to treat septage is needed before concept approval and before detailed designs can be evaluated by the design review staff.
- 3. The progress of the many countywide studies is such that this information is needed within a few months.
- 4. All counties conducting such studies would benefit from the information to be derived from the proposed pilot study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Division of Water Quality is authorized to enter into a new State Grant Contract or augment an existing State Grant Contract in an amount necessary to fund the local share of the costs of a pilot study of septage treatment lagoons.
