STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-57

APPROVAL OF POLICY ON DISCRETE SEWERAGE FACILITIES ADOPTED BY THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS:

- 1. On June 16, 1966, the Regional Board adopted a policy statement, Resolution No. 768, with respect to sewerage in urbanizing areas of the Region.
- 2. The application of Resolution No. 768 has been difficult due to its indirect nature (it requests City and County government to act rather than stating the Regional Board will act).
- 3. The Regional Board felt the necessity to clarify its policy on new discrete sewerage systems.
- 4. The Regional Board has prepared a negative declaration in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Section 21000, et seq) and the State guidelines, and the Regional Board determines that there will be no substantial adverse change in the environment as a result of the project.
- 5. The Regional Board held public hearings on this policy on September 30, 1977, October 18, 1977, December 20, 1977, April 18, 1978, and July 18, 1978.
- 6. The Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 78-14, "Policy on Discrete Sewerage Facilities", which rescinds Resolution No. 768.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves Resolution No. 78-14, "Policy on Discrete Sewerage Facilities", of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, which rescinds and replaces Resolution No. 768.
