STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-58

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE STINSON BEACH COUNTY WATER DISTRICT FOR A DEMONSTRATION ON-SITE WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

- 1. On-site systems can provide a less expensive method of wastewater management for the rural community than conventional collection and central treatment systems. This would have a significant beneficial impact on the State's water quality programs by reducing the cost of wastewater management projects in rural areas by eliminating the need for expensive wastewater collection.
- 2. To be reliable, on-site systems require appropriate routine inspection and maintenance. The public on-site wastewater management district concept would insure the proper inspection and maintenance for on-site systems.
- 3. Information on the costs and procedures for public onsite wastewater management districts is needed by State Board staff, local agencies, and consultants to provide a reliable basis for evaluating this wastewater management alternative.
- 4. The opportunity is available to assist with and study the implementation of a full-scale on-site wastewater management district in a rural community which will demonstrate the procedures, costs, and facilities required for an on-site wastewater management district.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Executive Director is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the Stinson Beach County Water District for a demonstration on-site wastewater management district for a duration not to exceed two years and an amount not to exceed \$48,000.
