STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-61

AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT EPA GRANTS AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES AND OFFICE OF APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY FOR PHASE II OF RURAL WASTEWATER DISPOSAL ALTERNATIVES STUDY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board has supported Phase I and the planning task of Phase II of the Rural Wastewater Disposal Alternatives Study.
- 2. In cooperation with the Department of Health Services and the Office of Appropriate Technology, the State Board submitted a proposal to EPA for funding the field demonstration and education tasks of the Rural Wastewater Disposal Alternatives Study, Phase II.
- The EPA has offered a partial grant and indicated additional funding will be granted following submission of an acceptable workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Executive Director be authorized to accept grants from EPA for the field demonstration and education tasks of the Rural Wastewater Disposal Alternatives Study, Phase II.
- 2. The Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute contracts with the Department of Health Services and the Office of Appropriate Technology for the studies for a duration not to exceed 15 months and an amount not to exceed the amount of the EPA grants plus \$47,500 of Clean Water Bond Funds.
