## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-69

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, SAN FRANCISCO BAY BASIN, TO INCLUDE BOARD APPROVED WATER QUALITY RELATED ACTIONS FROM ABAG'S 208 PLAN

## WHEREAS:

- 1. In May 1975, the Board designated the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) as the Areawide Waste Treatment Planning Agency for the San Francisco Bay Area pursuant to Section 208 of PL 92-500;
- In May 1976, the Board approved ABAG's detailed workplan for the preparation
  of an Environmental Management Plan (EMP) which would include an attempt
  to integrate water quality, water supply, solid waste, and air quality elements;
- 3. ABAG prepared an Environmental Management Plan which was adopted by ABAG's General Assembly on June 10, 1978;
- 4. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board held a public hearing on the proposed basin plan amendments on July 13, 1978;
- 5. The Regional Board, at its July 18, 1978, Board meeting, adopted Resolution No. 78-15 which adopts the following water quality related policies and actions of the EMP as amendments to the basin plan:

Water Quality Management Plan Actions 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 3.1, 3.2, 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 5.1, 5.2, 6.1, 9.1, 9.2, 9.4, 11.1, 11.2, 11.3, 11.4, 11.5, 11.6, and the 20-year project list.

Water Supply Management Plan Actions 1.1, 3.1, and 3.2.

Solid Waste Management Plan Actions 11.3, 12.1, 12.2, 12.4, 13.4, 13.6, 15.1, 16.1, 16.2, 16.3, and 16.4.

6. All policies and actions adopted as basin plan revisions were adopted as a part of the 208 plan for the San Francisco Bay Area by the State Board at its September 25, 1978, Board meeting.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves Resolution No. 78-15 of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board which amends the Water Quality Control Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin.
