STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-75

AUTHORIZING FUNDING OF THE LOCAL SHARE OF PLANNING STUDIES FOR UNSEWERED COMMUNITIES IN SAN JOAQUIN, TEHAMA, TULARE, MARIPOSA, TUOLUMNE AND MADERA COUNTIES

WHEREAS:

- Additional detailed studies are required to determine if continued use
 of septic tanks would result in water quality or public health problems.
- These studies should logically be funded under Section 201 due to the site specific nature.
- 3. These studies will aid in the formation of on-site maintenance districts and promote more cost-effective solutions to septic tank problems.
- 4. These studies will undoubtedly eliminate some priority Class "D" Step 1's from being funded with subsequent determinations that no problems exist.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Division of Water Quality is authorized to enter into new State Grant Contracts or augment existing State Grant Contracts for these six counties in an amount necessary to fund the "local share" of the costs of unsewered area planning studies.
