STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-2

AUTHORIZING REVISIONS TO STANDARD AGREEMENT W6-047-32, AND EXTENSION OF COMPLETION DATE TO APRIL 30, 1979

WHEREAS:

- The Board entered into Standard Agreement W6-047-32 with the Regents of the University of California at San Diego for the purpose of obtaining information on the initial dilution performance of ocean discharges and coastal mixing processes.
- Task 3, which required a comprehensive data review of large scale mixing processes, an analysis of "worst case" mixing conditions, and development of a 10 kilometer computer model, was not addressed in the final report submitted February 22, 1978.
- It has been determined that the development of a coastal dispersion model for Southern California coastal water with 10 kilometer resolution is infeasible.
- The University has proposed revisions to Task 3 which would provide the Board with useful information on the degree of interference between adjacent ocean outfalls, and requested a time extension to complete the work.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Director to amend Standard Agreement W6-047-32 to revise original Task 3 in accordance with the description set forth in Exhibit A (attached) and to extend the date for completion to April 30, 1979.
