STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-6

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 7 108 41 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF USING IRRIGATION RETURN WATERS FOR AQUACULTURE (Expansion of Scope of Work, Extension of Time, and Augmentation of Funds)

WHEREAS:

- The State Board has contracted with the Department of Water Resources to conduct a research program to evaluate the feasibility of using irrigation return waters for aquaculture.
- 2. Staff of the Board and the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program have identified needs for more in-depth work on both boron and arsenic than was initially proposed. In addition, due to vandalism and burglary at the laboratory facility, some equipment must be replaced.
- 3. The contract stated that the Board would provide the Program Manager for the project. The decision was made to contract with the University of California at Davis for the Program Manager. This process has delayed the key tasks of the research for nearly six months.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute an amendment to Interagency Agreement No. 7 108 41 with the Department of Water Resources for a study of the feasibility of using irrigation return waters for aquaculture (1) to expand the scope of work to be performed, (2) to extend the agreement to February 23, 1980, and (3) to augment the contract in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.
