AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A
CONTRACT WITH STANFORD UNIVERSITY FOR A
STUDY OF THE BEHAVIOR OF ORGANIC POLLUTANTS
IN GROUNDWATER RECHARGE

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board in 1976 provided partial support to Stanford University for research on groundwater recharge of reclaimed water at Palo Alto, California.
2. The major federal funding for the research will not be available during the next year, during which the effects of travel through soil are expected to be observed.
3. Stanford University has proposed a reduced program of research for State Board funding to study organics at five key wells.
4. The proposed research offers significant potential value for water reclamation decisions in California.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The State Board authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Stanford University for a study of the behavior of organic pollutants in groundwater recharge for a duration not to exceed 15 months and an amount not to exceed \$117,100.
